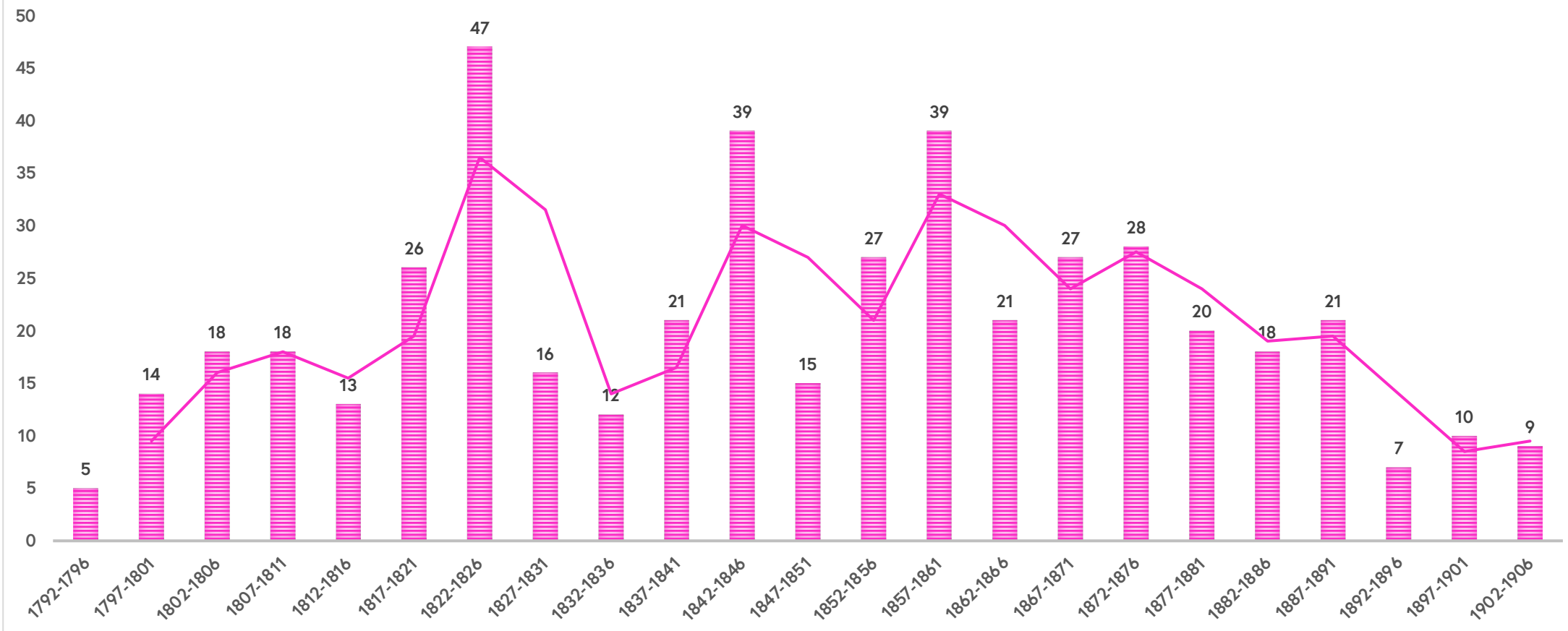
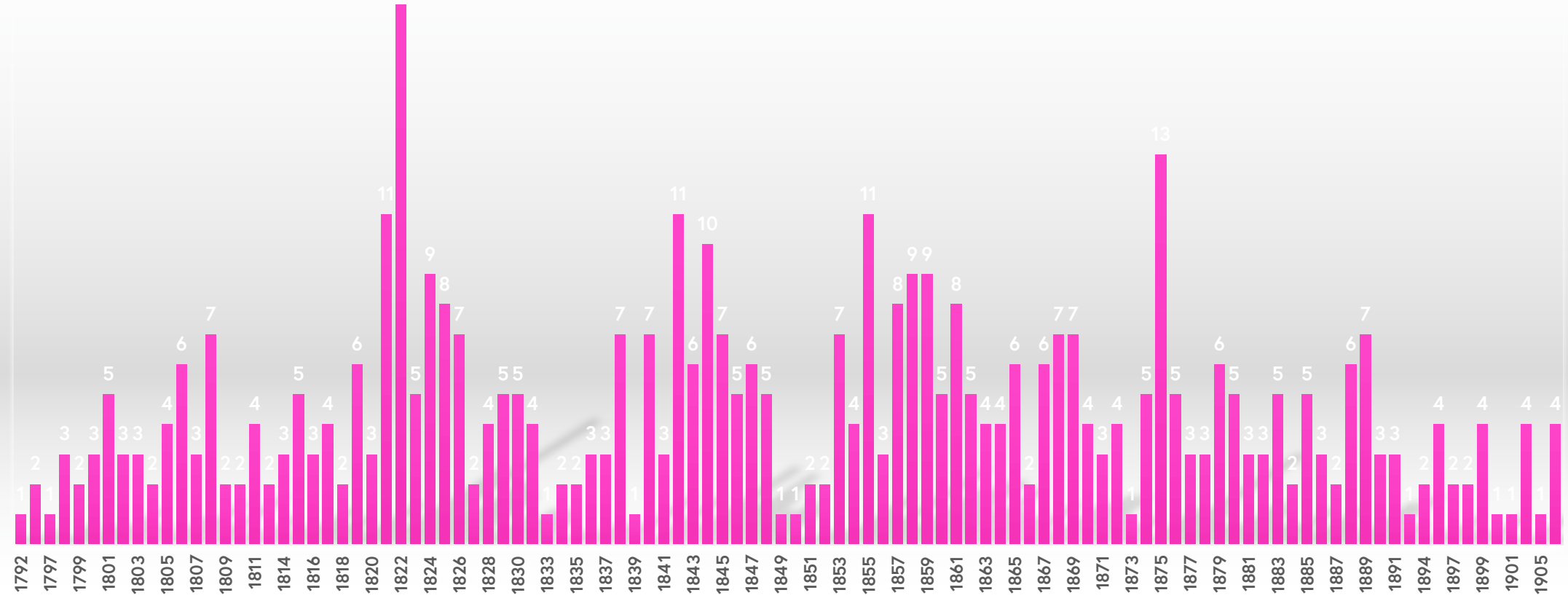

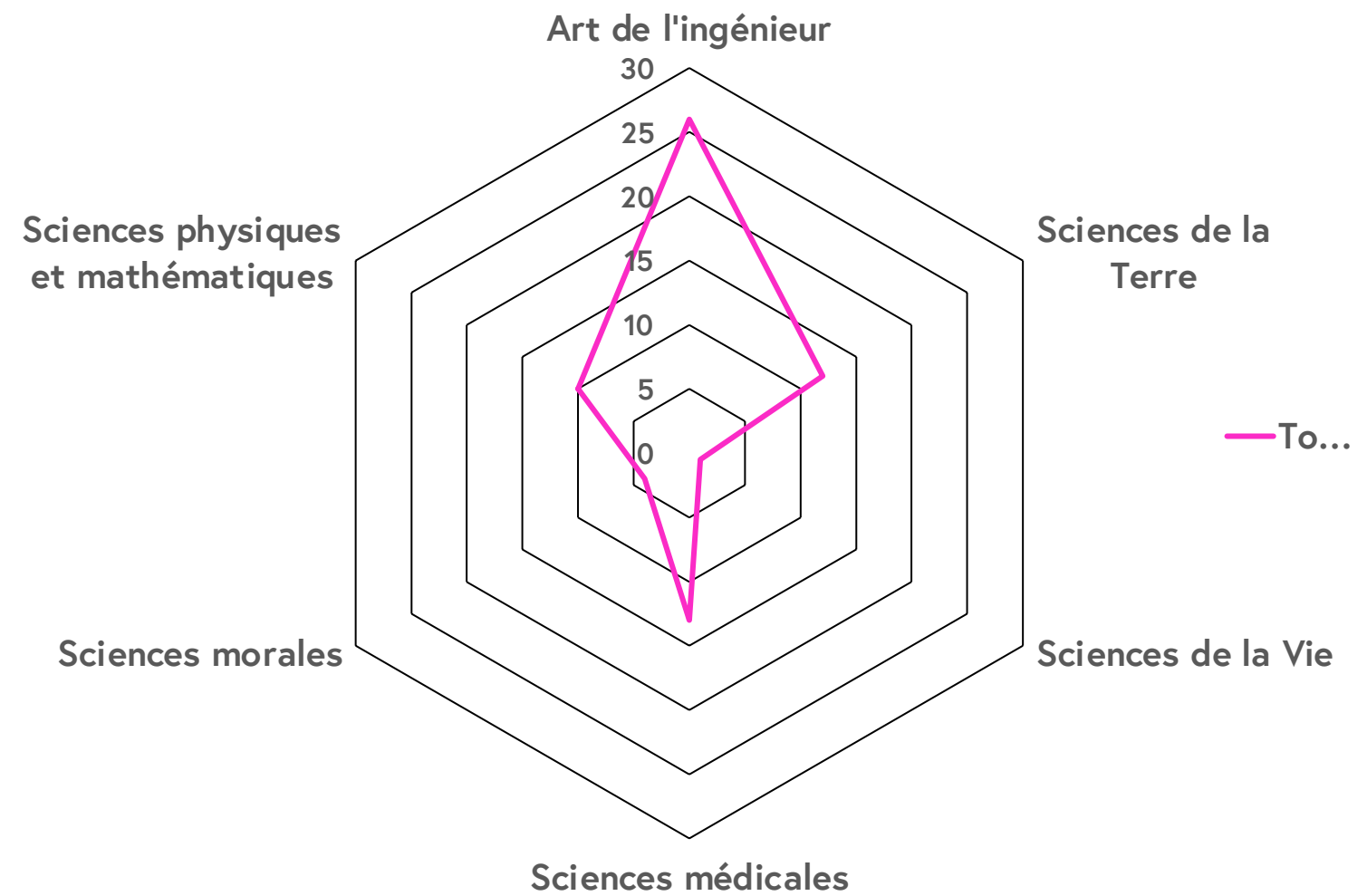
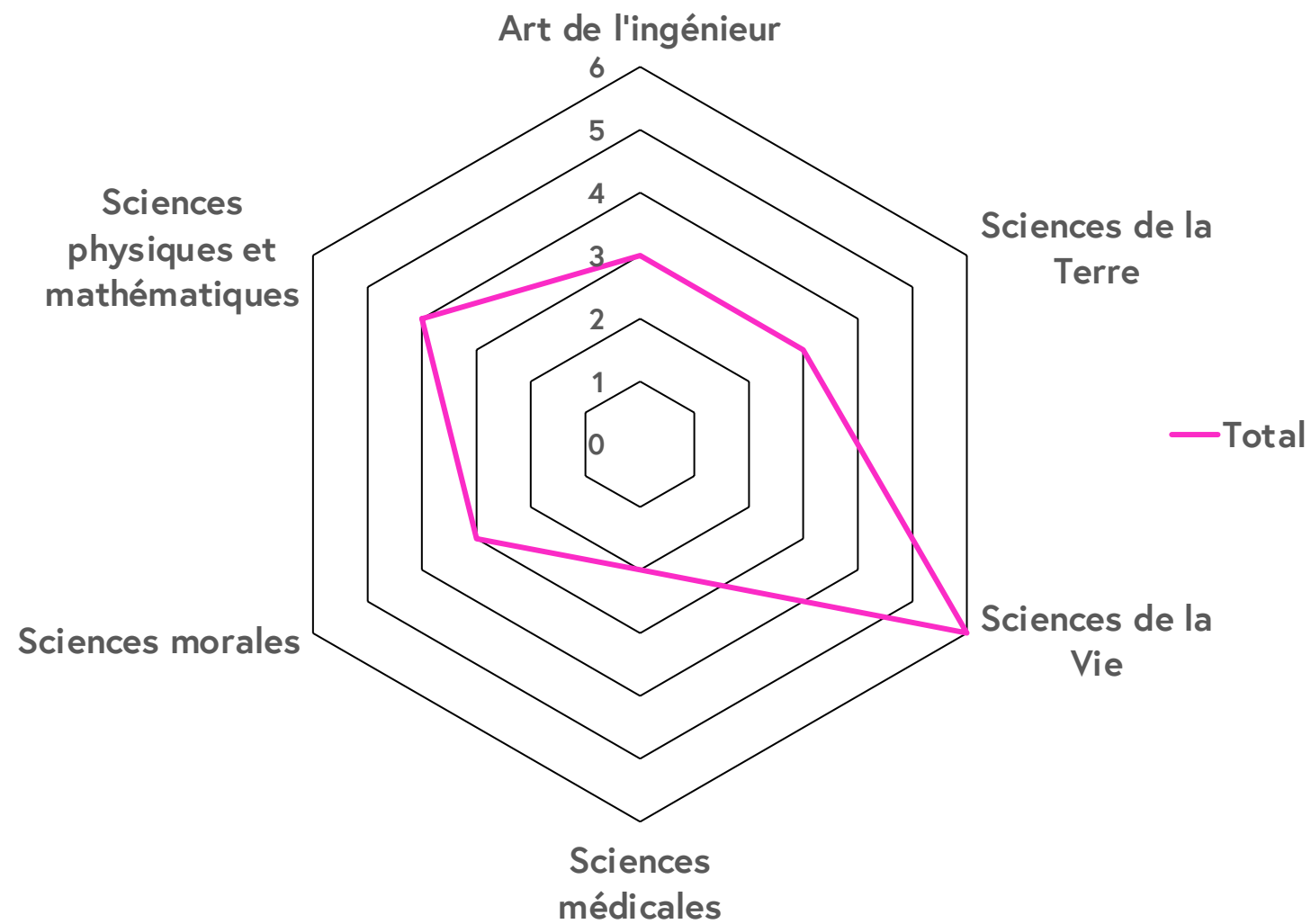
## Rythme des parutions

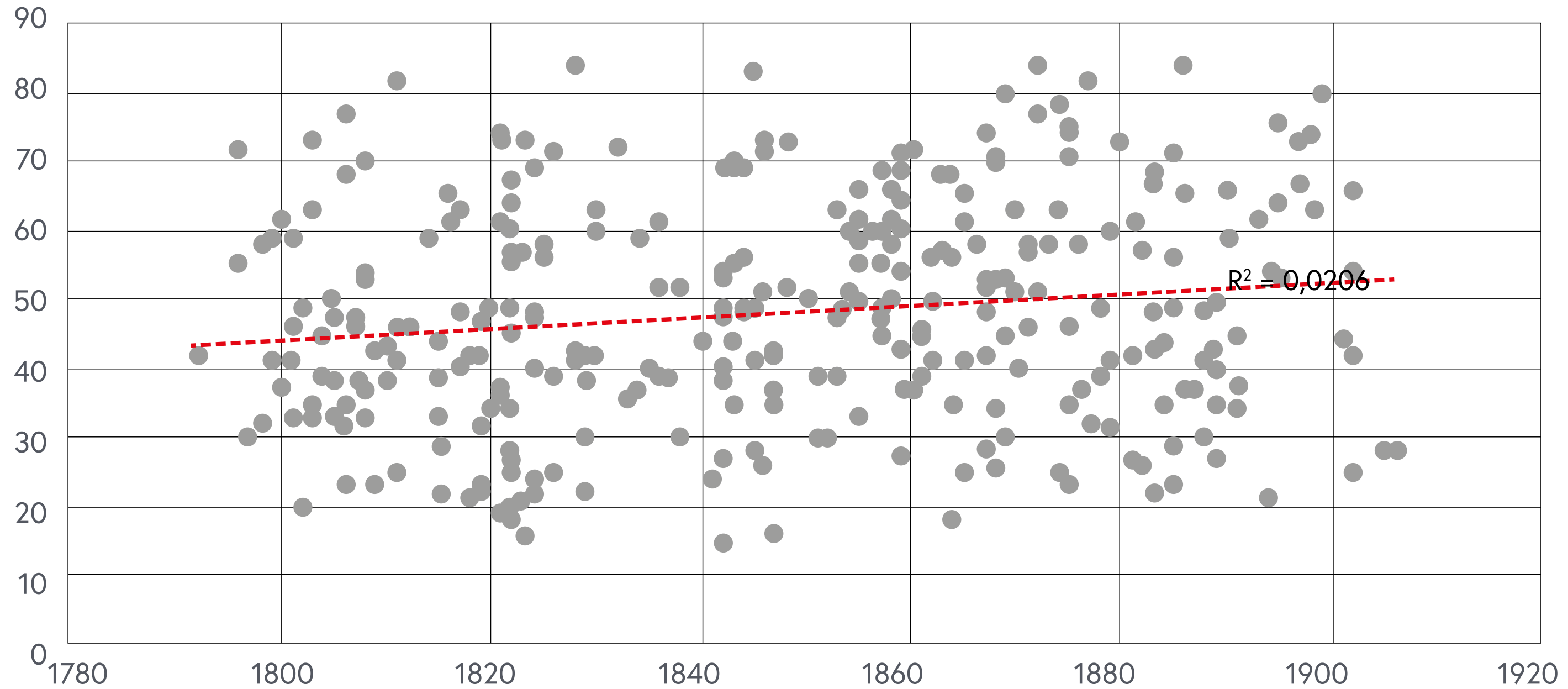
